

# Club Championship 2020 Rules

## Format

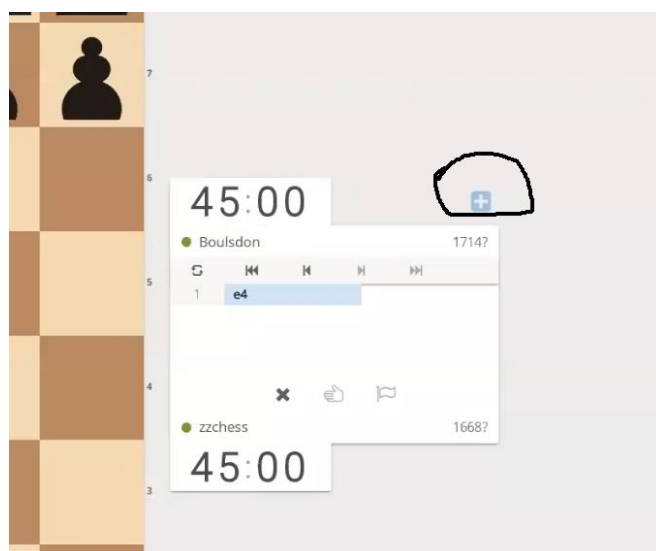
1. The event will be a 5 round Swiss style competition.
2. Each game will be played with the time control of 45+15. This means that all players have 45 minutes to complete the game with a 15 second increment added every move.

## Playing Rules

1. The draw for each round will be made after each round is completed and will be available online at <https://www.abergavennyChessclub.co.uk/CC2020/index.html>. The draw will be available no later than 09:00 on the Monday before the round.
2. Games should ideally be played starting at 19:30 on the Wednesday of the round. However, players may agree to play on a different day and/or time, provided that the game is completed by midnight on the Sunday before the next round. If this happens, both players should inform the controller of when the game is to be played.
3. The player drawn as white in each round should issue the challenge. However, if any player is having difficulty in doing so, then the black player may issue the challenge.
4. Results should be sent to the controller as soon as the game is finished.

## Disconnections

1. There is no option to pause the clock so, in the event of a player losing connection, the clock will continue to run. However, there is an option to give your opponent extra time. Whether or not to use this option is up to each individual player.



2. If a player is unable to re-join the game before their time runs out, then they will be deemed to have lost the game.
